

6 months

Your child's 6 month visit will include a routine physical exam, an assessment of growth and development, anticipatory guidance with a focus on feeding and sleeping, and routine vaccines. If your child is 6 months or older during the influenza season they will receive their first flu vaccine.

At this visit:

- Full physical exam
- Assessment of growth and development
- Monitoring of developmental milestones such as babbling and sitting with support
- Anticipatory guidance on topics including feeding, sleep, development and safety
- Edinburgh Post-Partum Depression screen
- Immunizations—DTaP, IPV, Hep B, HIB, Pneumococcus (Influenza if indicated)
